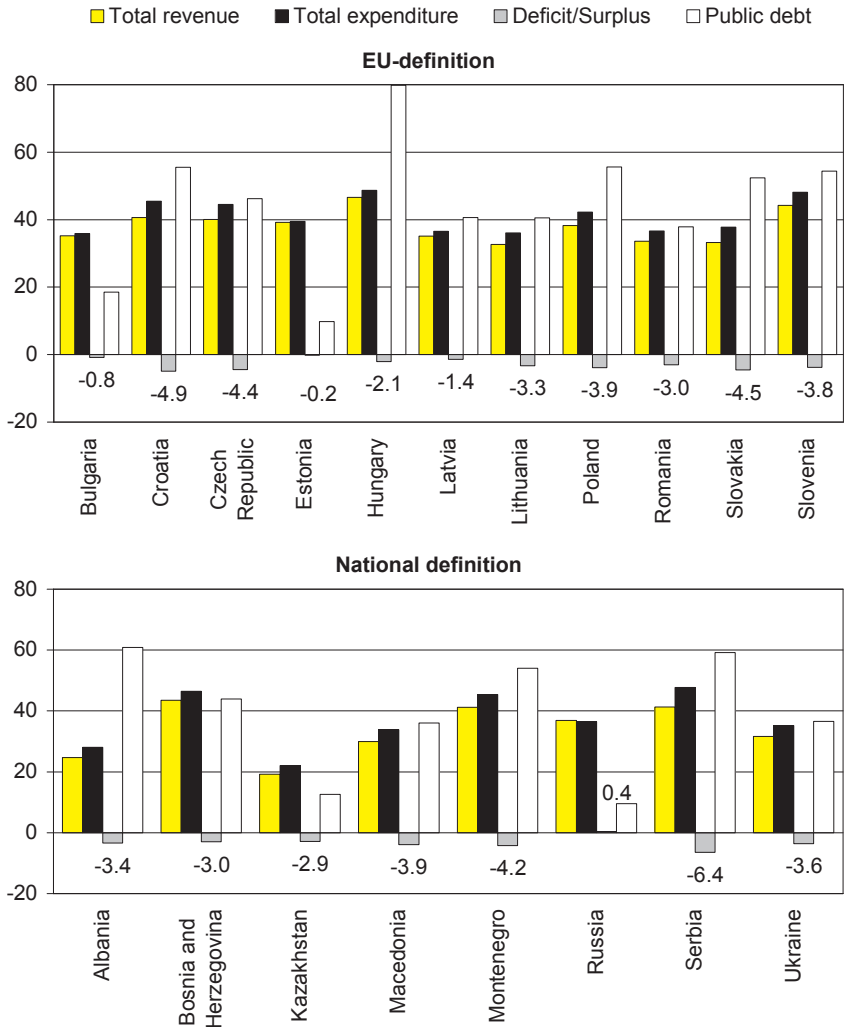

% of GDP

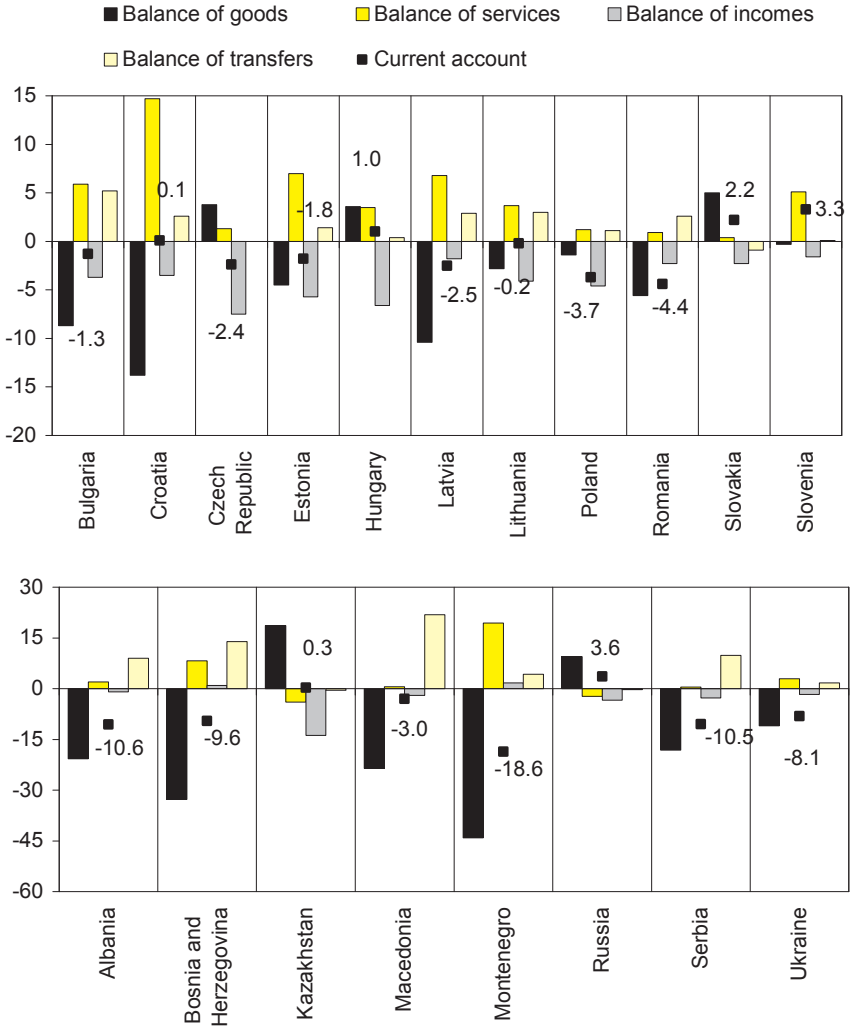

% of GDP

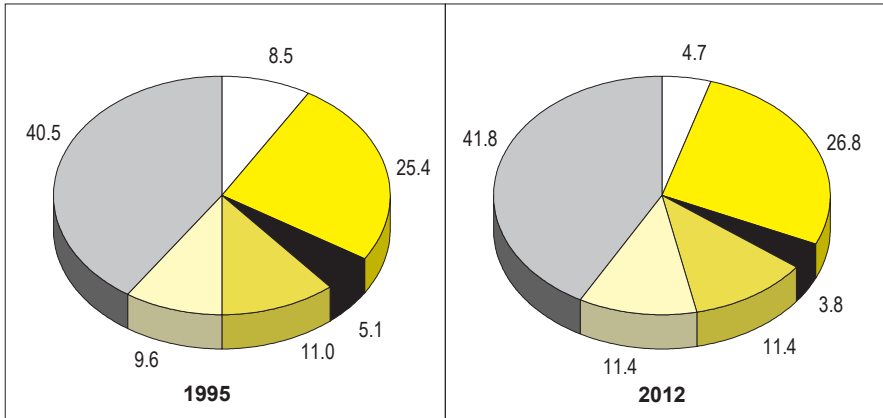

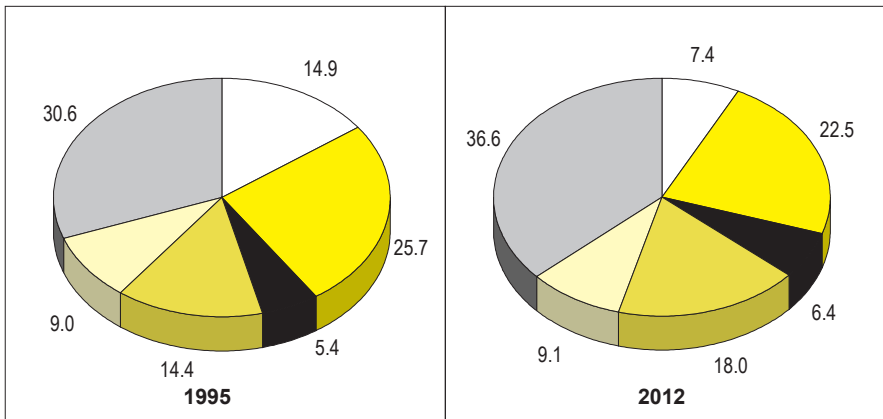

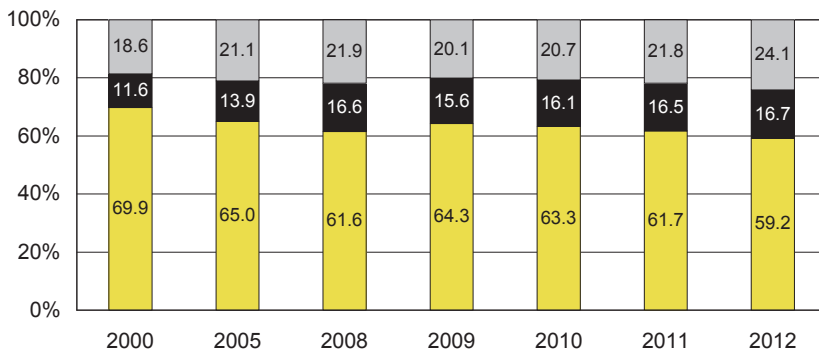

**Poland: Foreign trade by country groupings**

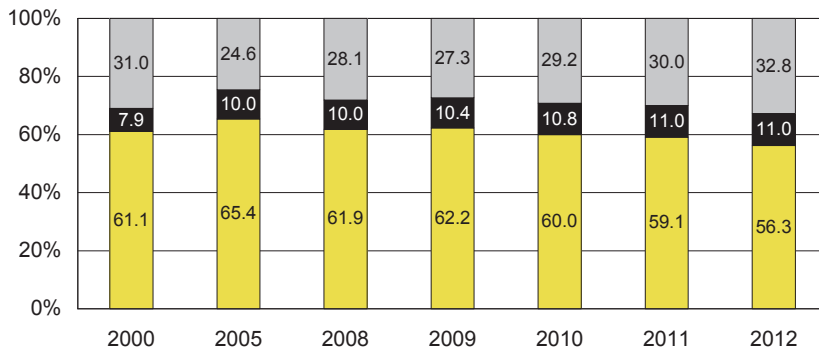

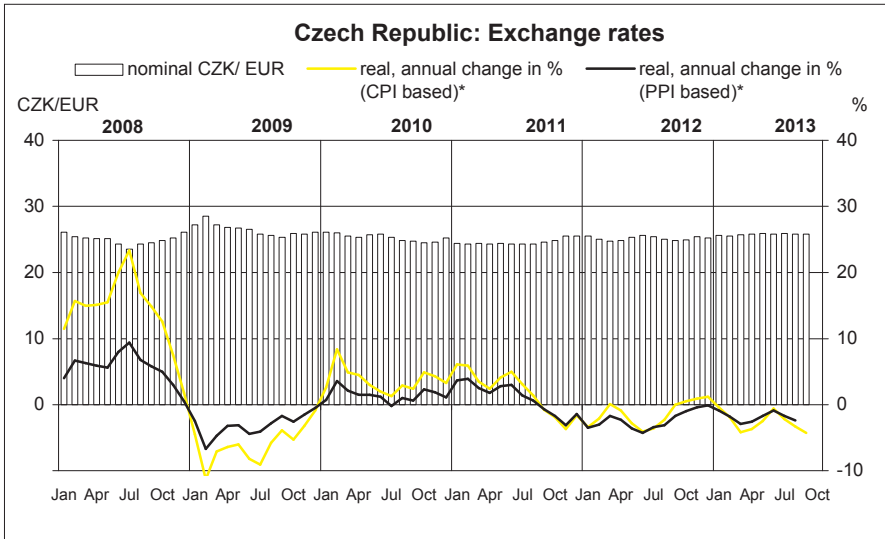

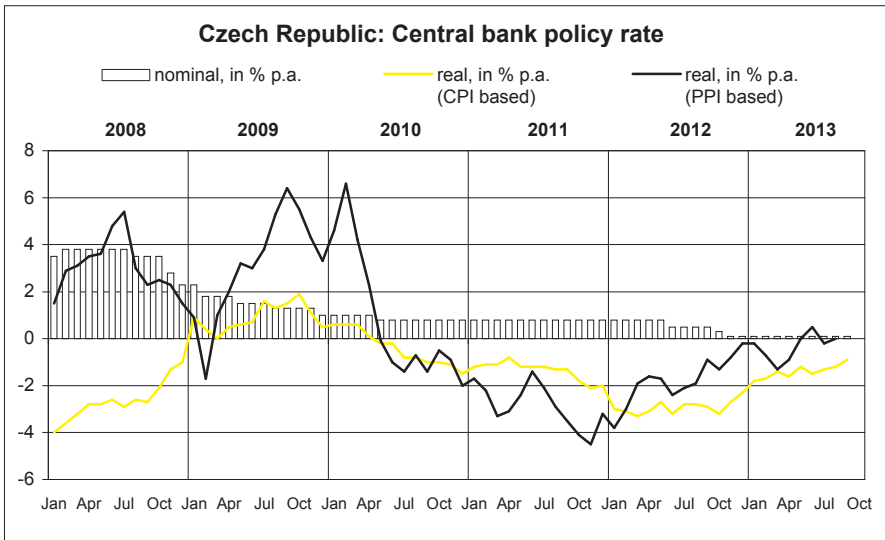

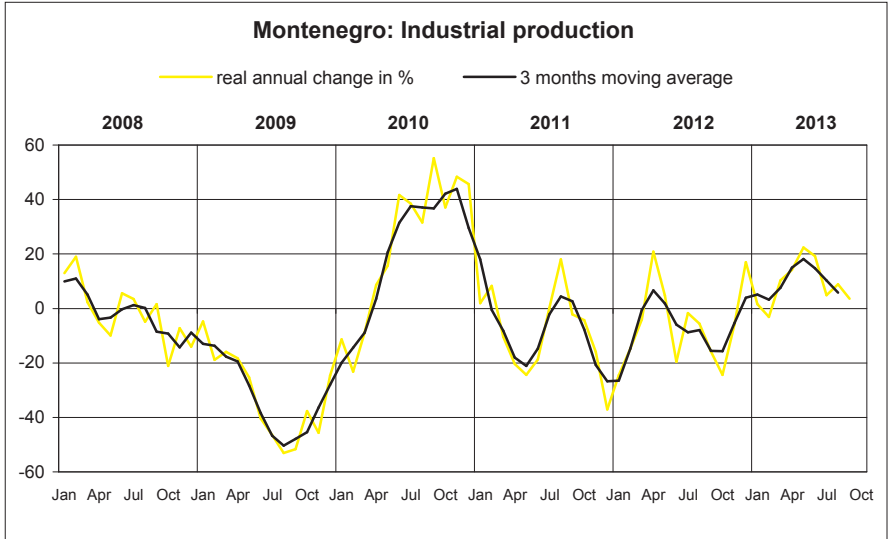
