# Tax Expenditure Analysis

- Developed a comprehensive catalogue of tax reliefs and exemptions for various revenue sources in Kosovo and collaborated with a team from the Ministry of Finance in Kosovo and the World Bank to analyze tax policies.
- Facilitated the acquisition of taxpayer data such as data on personal income, corporate income, businesses etc., and integrated them with macroeconomic and other relevant sources to identify the total tax base as well as feed a tax microsimulation model.

# Macroeconomic Monitoring

- Monitoring an exhaustive range of indicators from more than 3 key institutions related to various macroeconomic sectors in Kosovo (external, real, financial, fiscal, etc.) to analyze trends as well as establish a forecasting base.
- Establishing an automated data pipeline that involves collecting, transforming, analyzing, visualizing as well as reporting data that feeds periodical and regular reports as well as a centralized country database for macroeconomics via tools such as **R** (data processing) and **Excel** (database management and visualization).
- Drafting key sections related to recent economic developments in periodic reports such as the Western Balkans Regular Economic Report and Development Policy Financing report.
